Before you complete the below service resume form, we would like to let you know a little more about service at the Area level. The position for which you have been nominated will require that you make a commitment of 12 months. **Our election month for each position is as follows: 1. Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and ALL Subcommittee Chairs are in October. 2. Treasurer and Vice Treasurer is in January. 3. RCM & RCMA are in July.** This means that you may be asked to make an investment of your time.

You will be asked to travel to Area Service Committee meetings. This means that on a monthly basis (every 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday), you are required to attend. **Article 11.01 of our By-Laws states that:**

“The KMASC may declare vacant the office of any elected officer or subcommittee chair that has:

- 1) Not been present for two consecutive KMASC meetings;
- 2) Not represented the KMASC for two consecutive WRSC meetings (RCM and RCMA only);
- 3) Been found unfit as determined by the committee as a whole.”

Certainly you will have work to do in your spare time, such as reading, writing reports, making phone calls, speaking, and discussing the plans and objectives of your work with other members of your committee. (Having subcommittee meetings if you are a Chair.)

In order to provide our fellowship with the very best level of service possible, we ask that you carefully consider the responsibilities that go with the elected position for which you have been nominated. Service has many rewards and may have a profound effect on your life and personal recovery. However, it does not come without hard work, dedication, and personal sacrifice.
