Envelopes	For submitting Literature Order Forms and money to the Literature Chair. For submitting KMASC donations to the Secretary. Prepare these envelopes at your group business meeting.
Consensus Based Voting Options	Explanations of voting options at KMASC meetings: give consent, stand aside, and block. Other voting options can be found in our Bylaws in the "Voting Procedures and Bylaw Changes. As a GSR, you are voting members of the KMASC; please read and understand this information.
NA Acronyms	Explanations for KMA, KMASC, WRSC, NAWS; and many more.
